



Camp LIVIN COVID-19 Control Plan

Our highest priority is to provide a safe and healthy environment for our families and volunteers. In accordance with best practices and guidelines from the Centers for Disease Control, American Camp Association, and the Minnesota Department of Health, we have developed these COVID-19 protocols for Camp LIVIN. We acknowledge that the information regarding COVID-19 and its variants are changing frequently and we will be monitoring things closely. Should revisions be needed we will communicate them to folks as soon as possible. While we are taking steps to ensure Camp LIVIN is as safe and fun as possible, participation in camp is not free of risk. We encourage and support consultation with your family member's health care providers to assess their situation and determine if participation is advised. We trust families to make participation decisions based on their comfort with these risks.

Preparing For Camp:

Plan to arrive healthy! Families and volunteers are asked to please consider:

- Limiting their exposure with unvaccinated people or crowds for two weeks prior to your arrival at camp.
- Avoiding all non-essential travel and gatherings, including but not limited to restaurants, social gatherings, etc.
- Mask wearing in groups and indoor spaces outside of the home environment.
- 6 feet physical distance in groups outside of the home environment.
- Conscious awareness of risk factors associated with COVID transmission.
- Immunity boosting practices: rest, vitamins, healthy diet, etc.

If you have been exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 or developed symptoms yourself within the two weeks prior to Camp LIVIN, we ask that you not attend camp. If this is the case, please call Maria at (612)-805-0991.

COVID Protocols At Camp

- All family members and volunteers must complete a COVID health screening each morning.
- All family members and volunteers will have their temperatures taken upon check-in. Temperatures must be below 100.4 degrees in order to participate in camp.
- Masks will be required when indoors (except when swimming or eating) and when 6 feet of social distancing cannot be maintained.
- Family members and volunteers will be asked to bring their own supply of masks for the weekend.
- Families and volunteers will be organized into small activity groups during their time at camp. Interaction between groups will be limited to time when outdoors and wearing masks, with the exception of swimming and sleeping.
- Activities will be planned to accommodate physical distancing.
- All activities and meals during Camp LIVIN will occur outdoors weather permitting.

Medical Support & Response

- Camp LIVIN does not provide a licensed medical professional at Camp.
- Families should promptly communicate with the Camp LIVIN directors regarding any symptoms of illness or suspected cases of COVID-19.
- In the event of any symptoms of illness, family members and/or volunteers will be isolated and arrangements made for them to return home.. Due to the short nature of our camps, the person will not be permitted to return to the camp session.

After Camp

- Following camp, if a camper or staff has a positive COVID-19 test within 10 days of returning home, they are required to report it to Camp LIVIN. Camp LIVIN will then report it to families and staff from that session, without identifying the individual who tested positive.
